

Shape Tool Assignment

Assignment Description:

Become familiar with the various aspects of the shape tools.

Directions:

- **Start New Document:**
 - o Size: 8x10 inches
 - o Resolution: 100 dpi

- **Create the following shapes:**
 1. A small, red rectangle.
 2. A medium, dark green square.
 3. A small, orange perfect circle.
 4. A large, light blue rectangle with rounded edges (size=78 pixels).
 5. A small, black triangle.
 6. A medium, light grey octagon.
 7. A bright blue line (weight=5 px) that is exactly straight up & down.
 8. A yellow line (weight=12 px) that falls at an exact 45-degree angle.
 9. A small brown maple leaf in the top right corner.

- **Arrange the shapes in the following order:**
 - o Move the light blue (rounded-rectangle) layer to the bottom. Center it on the canvas.
 - o Move the small red rectangle layer to the top. Drag it so it sits on top of the yellow line.
 - o If any of the remaining shapes are completely hidden, drag them so part of the shape is showing. (They can still be overlapping to a certain extent).
