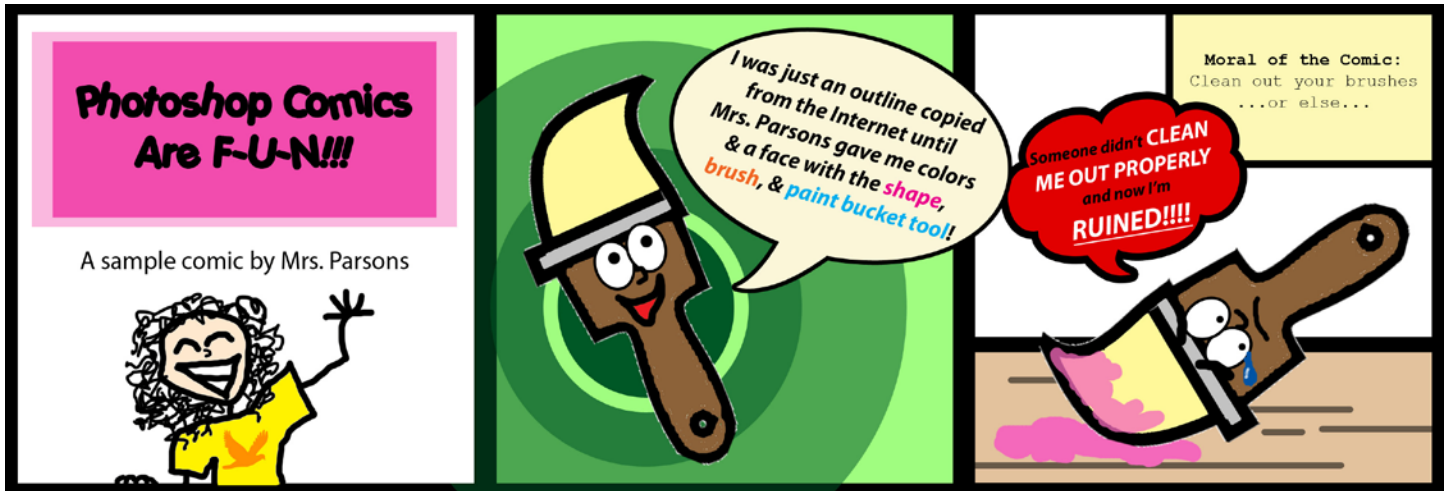


# Comic Strip Project

## Assignment Description:

*This project is designed to put into practice everything we've learned so far. Be creative and try to use all you know!*

## Directions:

- Brainstorm comic ideas.
  - o Sketch out your comic on paper before starting in Photoshop! *(This will help you think through what you need to do).*
  - o **Your comic needs to be at least 6 frames long.**
  
- **Start New Document:**
  - o Size: 4x12 inches
  - o Resolution: 250 dpi
  
- Drag 2 ruler guides to 4" and 8". (Break up your canvas into thirds).
  - o Each "third" of your canvas will be 1 frame.
  - o (Since you are making at least 6 frames, you will need to have at least 2 documents).
  
- **Make sure to include the following in your project:**
  - o Various shapes & lines. **(HINT: Ask me how to get "talk bubble" custom shapes)**
  - o Text
  - o Warped Text
  - o Ruler Guides
  - o Brush/Pencil Tool
  - o Paint Bucket
  - o **NOTE:** You will probably have lots of layers. Consider renaming layers, linking layers, and grouping layers into different folders to help organize them.
