Magazine Project

Assignment Description:

This project puts your newly-acquired selection skills into use by creating a magazine cover incorporating various cut-outs.

In this case, the man is cut out & so is the drum set.

Directions:

- Create a magazine cover that has at least 3 different cut-out objects.
 - Utilize whatever process that is easiest for you to cut out the pictures. (Any of the Lasso Tools, Magic Wand Tool, Quick Selection Tool, and/or Color Range Selection).
 - Most magazines only have 1 cut-out picture, but I want you to get creative & add at least 3. They don't
 all have to be big in the center! For example, you can have little cut-outs down the sides or in the
 corner...
- Choose a topic to base your magazine on. (Examples: Sports, Butterflies, SBCA, your friends, etc...)
- You can design your own magazine, or mimic (not copy!) a published magazine.
- Try to make it look as much like a real magazine cover as possible:
 - Add title, text, page numbers, barcode, banners/ribbons, sneak peeks, etc.
 **You don't need tons of text, but enough to make it look like a magazine.
 - Coordinate the colors on your cover! If you look at examples of magazine covers on the internet, you
 will see that most of them have a certain color scheme they try to stick with when coloring the text,
 boxes, shapes, clothing colors, etc.
